



## God's Promises for Your Children

*"Children are a gift from the LORD, they are a reward from him...  
How joyful is the man whose quiver is full of them!"*

*Psalm 127:3,5*

### **2 Corinthians 1:20**

For **all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen**, to the glory of God through us.

### What Has God Said About Your Children?

#### **1 Corinthians 7:14**

For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband: **else were your children unclean; but now they are holy. (Our children are holy. They are separated. They belong to God.)**

#### **Galatians 3:13-14**

**Christ purchased our freedom [redeeming us] from the curse (doom) of the Law** [and its condemnation] by [Himself] becoming a curse for us, for it is written [in the Scriptures], Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree (is crucified); To the end that through [their receiving] Christ Jesus, the blessing [promised] to Abraham might come upon the Gentiles, so that we through faith might [all] receive [the realization of] the promise of the [Holy] Spirit.

#### **Deuteronomy 28:32, 41 – The Curse of the Law**

32 Your sons and daughters shall be given to another people, and your eyes shall look and fail with longing for them all the day; and **there shall be no power in your hands to prevent it.**

41 You shall beget sons and daughters **but shall not enjoy them, for they shall go into captivity.**

**(According to Galatians 3:13, we are redeemed from this... we have power in our hands, we shall enjoy them – they will not be taken captive!)**

#### **Isaiah 54:13**

All your children *shall be* taught by the LORD, and **great shall be the peace (shalom) of your children.**  
**(Shalom= whole, sound, complete, nothing missing, & nothing broken)**

#### **Psalm 112:1-3**

Praise the LORD! Blessed *is* the man *who* fears the LORD, *Who* delights greatly in His commandments.

**His descendants will be mighty on earth; The generation of the upright will be blessed.**

Wealth and riches *will be* in his house, And his righteousness endures forever.

#### **Isaiah 49:25**

For thus says the Lord: Even the captives of the mighty will be taken away, and the prey of the terrible will be delivered; for **I will contend with him who contends with you, and I will give safety to your children and ease them.**

### **Psalm 91:7-11**

A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand, but **it shall not come near you**. Only a spectator shall you be [yourself inaccessible in the secret place of the Most High] as you witness the reward of the wicked. **Because you have made the Lord your refuge, and the Most High your dwelling place, There shall no evil befall you, nor any plague or calamity come near your tent. For He will give His angels [especial] charge over you to accompany and defend and preserve you in all your ways.**

### **Isaiah 44:3-4**

For I will pour water upon him who is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground. **I will pour My Spirit upon your offspring, and My blessing upon your descendants.** And they shall spring up among the grass like willows or poplars by the watercourses.

### **Isaiah 11:2-4 – His Spirit is Upon Our Children**

And **the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him--the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the reverential and obedient fear of the Lord-- And shall make Him of quick understanding, and His delight shall be in the reverential and obedient fear of the Lord.** And He shall not judge by the sight of His eyes, neither decide by the hearing of His ears; But with righteousness and justice shall He judge the poor and decide with fairness for the meek, the poor, and the downtrodden of the earth....

### **No Weapon Formed Against Your Children Shall Prosper (Isaiah 54:17)**

#### **Jeremiah 31:16-17**

Thus says the Lord: **Restrain your voice from weeping and your eyes from tears**, for your work shall be rewarded, says the Lord; **and [your children] shall return from the enemy's land. 17And there is hope for your future, says the Lord; your children shall come back to their own country.**

#### **Proverbs 11:21**

Though hand join in hand, the evil man shall not be unpunished; **But the seed of the righteous shall be delivered.**

### **You Have Power, You have a Voice**

#### **Mark 11:23**

So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God. 23 For assuredly, I say to you, **whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.**

#### **Deuteronomy 30:19-20**

I call heaven and earth to witness this day against you that **I have set before you life and death, the blessings and the curses; therefore choose life, that you and your descendants may live** And may love the Lord your God, obey His voice, and cling to Him. For He is your life and the length of your days, that you may dwell in the land which the Lord swore to give to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

#### **Proverbs 18:21**

**Death and life *are* in the power of the tongue**, And those who love it will eat its fruit.

#### **Job 22:28**

**You shall also decide and decree a thing, and it shall be established for you;** and the light [of God's favor] shall shine upon your ways.

## Your Prayers Make a Difference!

### Mark 11:24

Therefore I say to you, **whatever things you desire when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.**

### James 5:16-18

Confess to one another therefore your faults (your slips, your false steps, your offenses, your sins) and pray [also] for one another, that you may be healed and restored [to a spiritual tone of mind and heart]. **The earnest (heartfelt, continued) prayer of a righteous man makes tremendous power available [dynamic in its working].** Elijah was a human being with a nature such as we have [with feelings, affections, and a constitution like ours]; and he prayed earnestly for it not to rain, and no rain fell on the earth for three years and six months. [I Kings 17:1.] And [then] he prayed again and the heavens supplied rain and the land produced its crops [as usual]. [I Kings 18:42-45.]

### 1 John 5:14-15

And this is the confidence (the assurance, the privilege of boldness) which we have in Him: [we are sure] that **if we ask anything (make any request) according to His will (in agreement with His own plan), He listens to and hears us. And if (since) we [positively] know that He listens to us in whatever we ask, we also know [with settled and absolute knowledge] that we have [granted us as our present possessions] the requests made of Him.**

### Matthew 18:19-20

“Again I say<sup>g</sup> to you that **if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven.** 20 For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.”

### Philippians 4:6-9

**Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; 7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.** 8 Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things *are* noble, whatever things *are* just, whatever things *are* pure, whatever things *are* lovely, whatever things *are* of good report, if *there is* any virtue and if *there is* anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. The things which you learned and received and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you.
