



God's Promises for Long Life

Psalm 91:16- (Amp)

With long life will I satisfy him and show him My salvation.

Genesis 25:8- (NLT)

He died at a **ripe old age, having lived a long and satisfying life**. He breathed his last and joined his ancestors in death.

Genesis 6:3- (NLT)

Then the Lord said, "My Spirit will not put up with humans for such a long time, for they are only mortal flesh. **In the future, their normal lifespan will be no more than 120 years.**"

Isaiah 65:19-21- (NLT)

I will rejoice over Jerusalem and delight in my people. And the sound of weeping and crying will be heard in it no more. ²⁰ "No longer will babies die when only a few days old. **No longer will adults die before they have lived a full life. No longer will people be considered old at one hundred! Only the cursed will die that young!**" ²¹ In those days people will live in the houses they build and eat the fruit of their own vineyards.

Psalm 90:9-10- (Amp)

⁹For all our days [out here in this wilderness, says Moses] pass away in Your wrath; we spend our years as a tale that is told [for we adults know we are doomed to die soon, without reaching Canaan]. ^(B) ¹⁰The days of our years are ^(a)threescore years and ten (seventy years)--or even, if by reason of strength, fourscore years (eighty years); yet is their pride [in additional years] only labor and sorrow, for it is soon gone, and we fly away.

Amplified Notation:

Psalm 90:10 This psalm is credited to Moses, who is interceding with God to remove the curse which made it necessary for every Israelite over twenty years of age (when they rebelled against God at Kadesh-barnea) to die before reaching the promised land (Num. 14:26-35). Moses says most of them are dying at seventy years of age. This number has often been mistaken as a set span of life for all mankind. It was not intended to refer to anyone except those Israelites under the curse during that particular forty years. Seventy years never has been the average span of life for humanity. When Jacob, the father of the twelve tribes, had reached 130 years (Gen. 47:9), he complained that he had not attained to the years of his immediate ancestors. In fact, Moses himself lived to be 120 years old, Aaron 123, Miriam several years older, and Joshua 110 years of age. Note as well that in the Millennium a person dying at 100 will still be thought a child (Isa. 65:20).

Proverbs 3:2- (KJV)

¹MY SON, forget not my law or teaching, but **let your heart keep my commandments; for length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.**

Deuteronomy 4:40- (NLT)

If you obey all the decrees and commands I am giving you today, all will be well with you and your children. **I am giving you these instructions so you will enjoy a long life** in the land the Lord your God is giving you for all time.”

Deuteronomy 6:2- (NLT)

and you and your children and grandchildren must fear the Lord your God as long as you live. **If you obey all his decrees and commands, you will enjoy a long life.**

Deuteronomy 32:47- (NLT)

These instructions are not empty words—they are your life! **By obeying them you will enjoy a long life** in the land you will occupy when you cross the Jordan River.”

Psalms 34:11-13- (NLT)

Come, my children, and listen to me, and I will teach you to fear (reverence) the LORD. ¹² **Does anyone want to live a life that is long and prosperous?** ¹³ **Then keep your tongue from speaking evil and your lips from telling lies!**

Ephesians 6:3- (NLT)

If you honor your father and mother, “things will go well for you, **and you will have a long life on the earth.**”
